Did you know federal requirements will require you to be compliant with REAL ID?

The Federal REAL ID Act requires certain documents to renew your Maryland Driver's License or Identification Card

Did you know a Birth Registration Notice is NOT the same as a Birth Certificate?

- Birth registration notices are sent to new parents to let them know that the birth of their child had been officially registered
- A Birth Certificate will say "Certificate of Live Birth", while a Birth Registration Notice will say either "Registration of Birth" or "Certificate of Birth"
- A Birth Registration Notice is not an adequate document to prove age and identity

Just remember the REAL ID Core 4:

- Proof of Age and Identity: original or certified copy of your U.S. Birth Certificate or a valid, unexpired U.S. Passport
- Proof of Social Security: original Social Security Card, W-2 form, or a Social Security Administration Benefits Statement
- Two Proofs of Maryland Residency:
 Examples: Insurance Card, Vehicle
 Registration, Credit Card Bill, Utility Bill,
 etc.
