Did you know federal requirements will require you to be compliant with **REAL ID**?

The Federal REAL ID Act *requires certain documents* to renew your Maryland Driver's License or Identification Card

Did you know a Birth Registration Notice is NOT the same as a Birth Certificate?

- Birth registration notices are sent to new parents to let them know that the birth of their child had been officially registered
- A Birth Certificate will say "Certificate of Live Birth", while a Birth Registration Notice will say either "Registration of Birth" or "Certificate of Birth"
- A Birth Registration Notice is **not an adequate document to prove age and identity**

Just remember the **REAL ID Core 4**:

- 1** Proof of Age and Identity: original or certified copy of your U.S. Birth Certificate or a valid, unexpired U.S. Passport
- 2** Proof of Social Security: original Social Security Card, W-2 form, or a Social Security Administration Benefits Statement
- 3** **4** Two Proofs of Maryland Residency: Examples: Insurance Card, Vehicle Registration, Credit Card Bill, Utility Bill, etc.
