*This permit is granted under Air Quality Regulation 26.11.07 and is subject to the following restrictions:*

1. All burning shall cease when notified by the Health Department that an air pollution advisory is in effect
2. Burning shall not create a nuisance
3. This authorization is for the control of air pollution only and is not to be construed to allow burning in conflict with the Maryland Forest Service Regulations and/or local Fire Department regulations
4. If the burning site is within 200 feet of woodland, contact Maryland Forest Service 410-848-9290 for approval
5. Contact the Carroll County Office of Public Safety 410-386-2260 immediately before burning
6. **Certain incorporated municipalities in Carroll County have ordinances prohibiting open burning. If the burning site indicated on this permit is within town limits, contact town officials for their regulations. If the municipality prohibits burning, this permit is void.**
