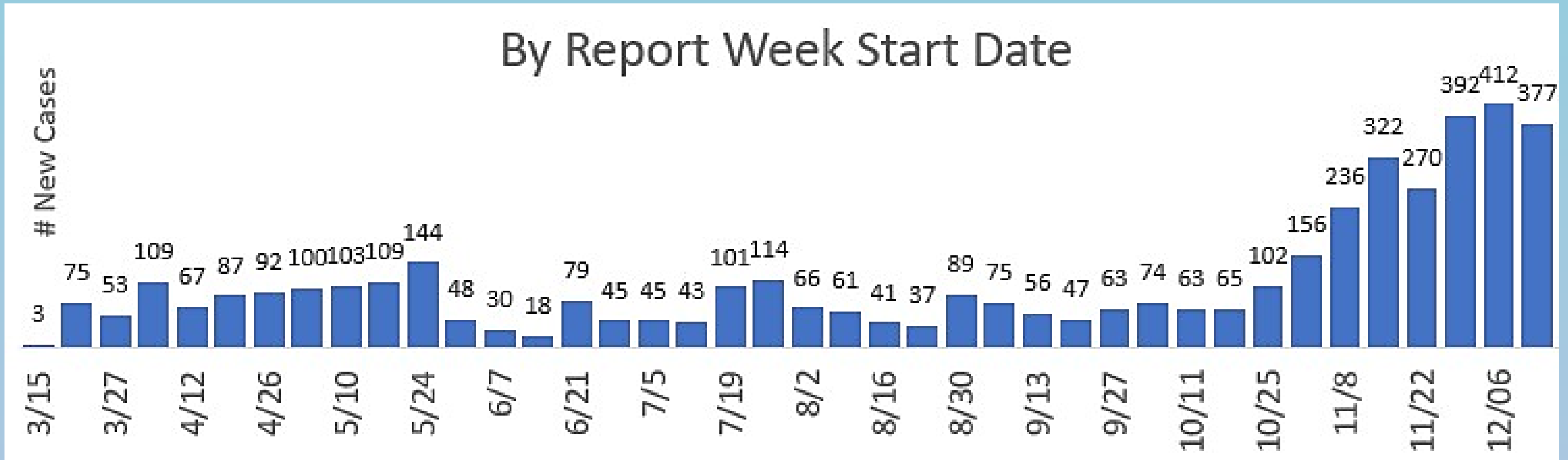

Total cases (community and facility) in Carroll County by Week



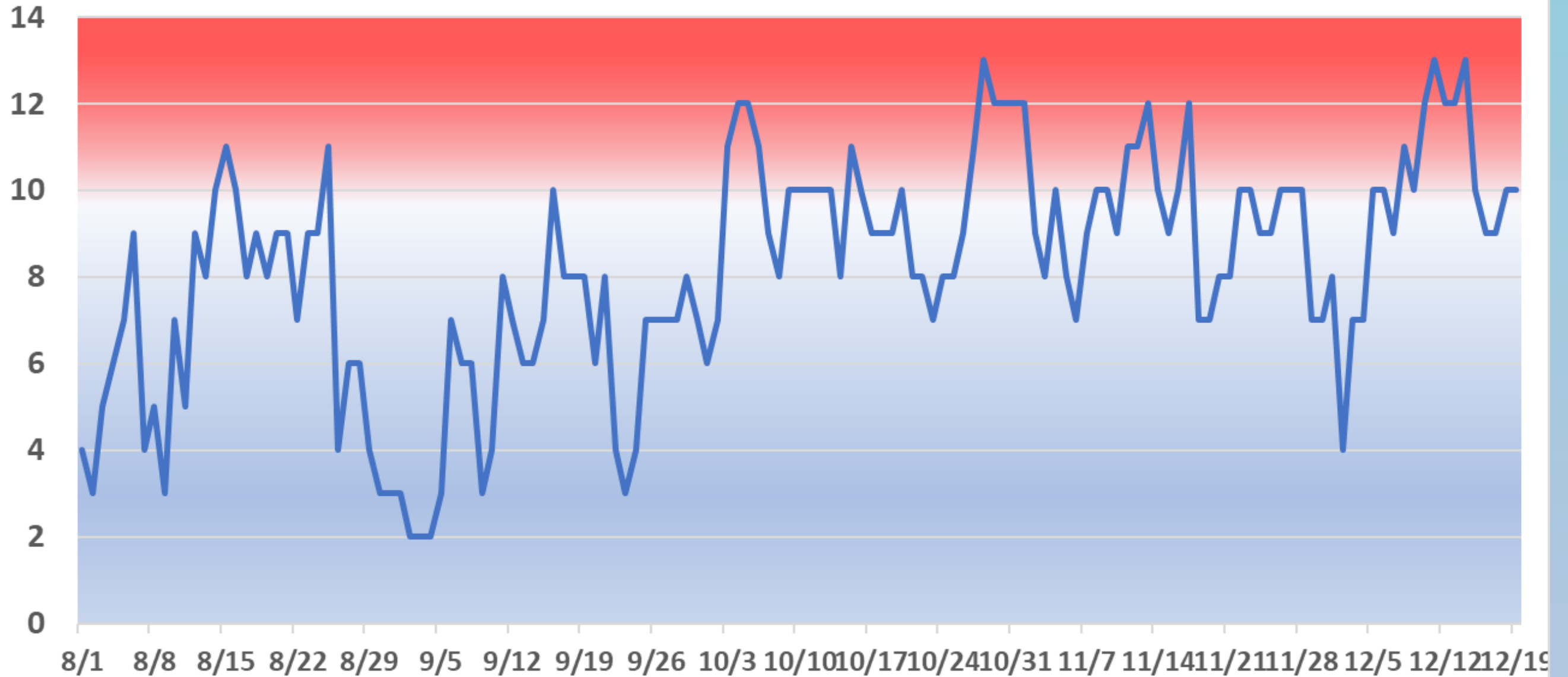

ICU Beds in Use



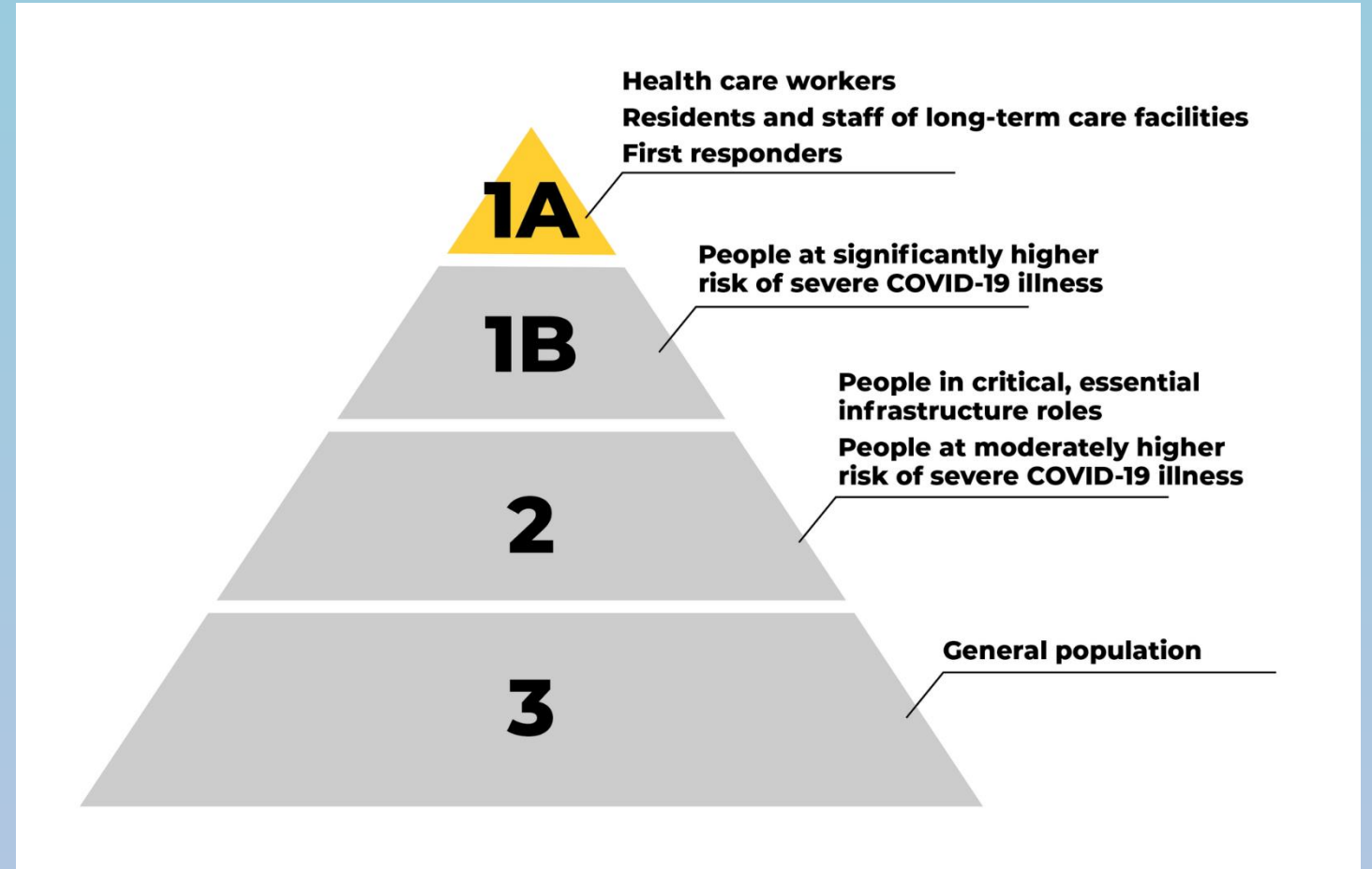
We are now sharing additional data updates from Carroll Hospital on our website.

Ag Center testing site

- Demand has increased significantly
 - Averaged around 95 tests/day in late August - early September
 - In December, averaging 212 tests/day
- Need to prioritize people who have been exposed to COVID-19 and people who have symptoms of COVID-19.
- Health Department clinicians will still be able to write orders for these individuals to receive testing without a doctor's order.
- People who need the test for other reasons such as travel or return to work may still use our testing site.
 - More people may need to test related to travel due to new travel orders:

- They will need to work with their provider to order their test through the CRISP information system.
- Other testing options may include provider offices, pharmacies, and urgent care clinics.
 - Check the type of test and ask about insurance coverage and charges.
